

# Using a Stamp-a-ma-jig

## Materials:

Stamp

Ink

stamp-a-ma-jig

imaging sheet(provided with your stamp-a-ma-jig)

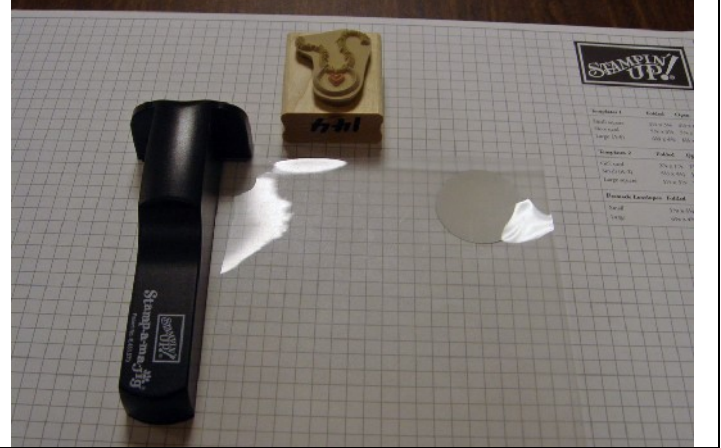


Ink your stamp.



Line imaging sheet up with corner of stamp-a-ma-jig.

\*\*Note the Stamp-a-ma-jig has notches on both sides for right and left handed use.

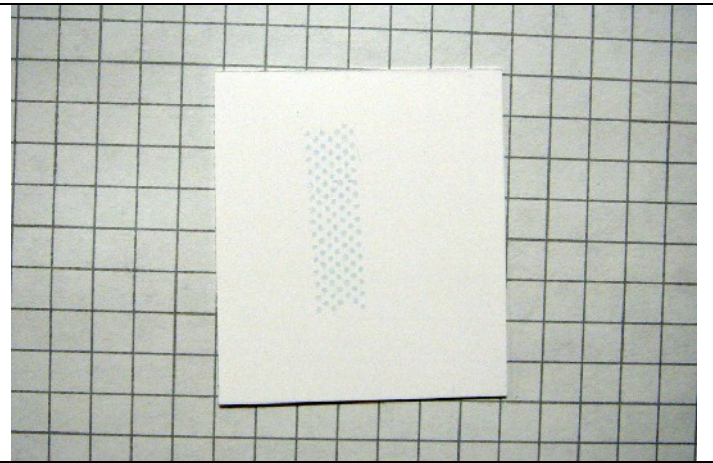


Lining up stamp in the corner of stamp-a-ma-jig, stamp on imaging sheet.

\*\*Note that Stampin' Up!'s Imaging sheet has a rough side and a smoother side. Use the smooth side for classic ink and the rough side for craft ink.



Lay paper on work surface. I use Dotto adhesive to hold it in place.



Line image on imaging sheet up on paper where you want to stamp it.



Line stamp-a-ma-jig up with imaging sheet.



Remove imaging sheet and stamp on paper.



You have a perfectly lined up image!

\*\*Note: To clean your imaging sheet, just wipe with damp cloth.



You can ink part of a stamp such as 'celebrate' on this stamp



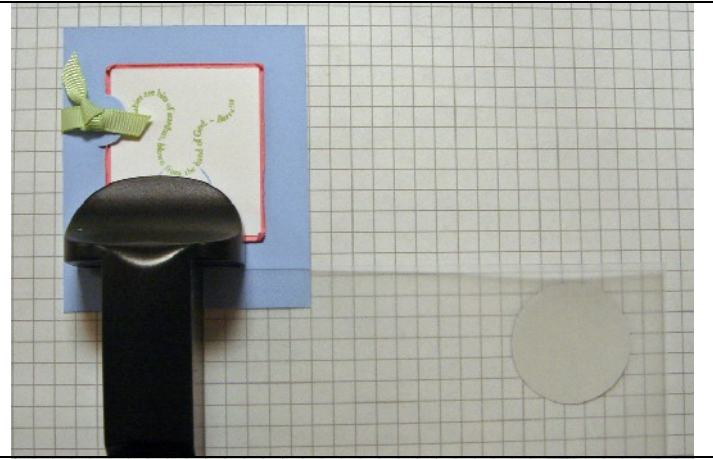
Line up imaging sheet with stamp-a-ma-jig and stamp.



Line up imaging sheet on paper.



Line up stamp-a-ma-jig with imaging sheet.



Remove imaging sheet and stamp image.



You again have a perfectly lined up image!

\*\*Note: Wipe off imaging sheet with a damp cloth to clean.
